In March, the Retreat Methodist Church acquired a new life-saving tool that can be utilized in the event of a choking emergency! The church's fellowship hall is now home to a new LifeVac Anti-Choking Kit. The LifeVac is a non-powered, non-invasive airway clearance device developed for resuscitating a victim with an airway obstruction when current choking

protocols have been followed without success. The church is excited to offer this life-saving tool to its visitors to better protect them and their loved ones.

After acquiring the device, the church became inspired to provide this tool to both the Liberty Pole and New Hope churches as well! So as part of their first quarter mission, Retreat donated a LifeVac tool to each church so that they too can be prepared to protect their members, friends, and visitors.
