At first, we could not meet in person. But over four years, those wonderful people have become family to me—and even more beloved than family. Their walk with God has enriched me and taught me, and I will bring all of them with me when I come to you. There is absolutely nothing like a life lived in a Christian community.

God brought me to ordination so that I could come to you. In a few weeks, I'll get to meet you in person and participate in a Sunday service. We are making preparation and cannot wait.
