Notes from Pastor Sandy

Hello Friends! As I write this, February is about half done, the fields are covered with snow and the temperature is minus 2! Winter is in full swing! But our churches continue to do the Lord's work and things are about to heat up.

We are working our way through Deuteronomy and will finish the Ten Commandments and then uncover the passages from Deuteronomy that Jesus used in His teachings over the month of March. Confirmation continues as well. We will have two sessions in March and two in April before the Confirmation Service. That's March 9 and March 23, and then April 6 and *April 13*. Note the change. No confirmation on Easter Sunday! The two sessions in March will still be at New Hope. The two in April will be at Retreat. Starting time will remain the same. That Palm Sunday session will only be about an hour, 3 – 4 p.m. We'll want to go over the service itself and discuss what parts the individual confirmands will play in the service. Please talk this over with your students. They can greet, ring the bell, usher, or read Scripture. If you have other ideas, let me know!



North West Prairie Church will be hosting the Ash Wednesday service on March 5th at 6 p.m. I will be preaching so I'd love to see you there.

The Second Pulpit opportunities for prayers and scripture will be starting soon. Let me know if you are interested and I'll start a list.

Growing a Lenten Prayer Tree

During the Lenten season, folks at the Retreat Methodist Church will get to help "grow" a Lenten Prayer Tree! What is a Lenten Prayer Tree? A Lenten Prayer Tree utilizes a tree or bunch of branches from which slips of paper are hung. Upon each piece of paper is a different prayer focus — either someone or something that you are praying about/for. As you head through Lent, the tree becomes more and more "full", representing not only your prayer life but also the new life that a right relationship with Jesus can bring!

As we head through Lent, slips of paper will be available during worship at Retreat.

Simply write your prayer focus on the slip of paper and then drop the paper in the basket after worship. The prayers will be added to our prayer tree for the next week, helping it grow as we head toward Easter Sunday. Everyone is invited to add to the prayer tree, even if you don't worship at Retreat!
